**Announcement of Institute Level SPOT - ACAP Round Admission for First Year
B. Tech (Engineering and Technology) candidates for Academic Year 2024 -25**

General Instructions:

1. The The SPOT-ACAP round will be conducted through the allotment process.
2. Students must report to the respective campus strictly according to the schedule to complete the reporting process.

3. The total number of available seats for the Institute Level Allotment (SPOT-ACAP) Round will include the vacant seats remaining after all centrally conducted CAP rounds by the State CET Cell and competent authorities, as well as any vacancies due to cancellations as mentioned in the schedule. Details will be displayed on the VIT Pune Institute's website and Notice Board.
 4. The admission process will follow the rules and regulations outlined in Section 13, page 79, of the information brochure published by the State CET Cell for the academic year 2024-25, as well as any guidelines received from competent authorities. For details, please refer to www.mahacet.org.
 5. According to State CET Cell rules, seat types such as TFWS and EWS that remain vacant after the completion of all CAP rounds shall not be filled during the ACAP round.
 6. The admission process will be conducted transparently and strictly based on the Inter-Se-Merit of candidates who applied to the State CET and subsequently applied online through the link provided on the VIT Pune website (www.vit.edu) by paying the processing fees.
 7. Allotment will be done as per the process given in information brochure published by State CET Cell for AY 2024 – 25 and the guidelines received from the competent authorities from time to time. (for details refer to www.mahacet.org)

8. While filling these seats, preference will be given to Maharashtra State Candidature Candidates over All India Candidature Candidates based on Inter-Se-Merit as outlined in the State CET Cell information brochure.
9. Non-refundable and non-transferable application processing fee of ₹ 2,000/- (₹ Two Thousand Only) is to be paid online through Institute Level Allotment / Direct Counselling (SPOT - ACAP) on Institute's application portal. The candidate should bring the hard copy of transaction details and the application form with all applicable documents, at the time of admission process, failing to which candidate shall not be considered for actual seat allotment.

11. No personal communication or allotment letters will be issued to the candidates in this regard.
12. All Candidates irrespective of their caste and category of admission, admitted through this round Institute Level Allotment (SPOT - ACAP), will have to pay full fees (applicable for open category). Fees for Vishwakarma Institute of Technology is ₹ 1,92,945/- (₹ One Lakh Ninety-Two Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-Five Only) and should be paid by Demand Draft / Online payment mode. Demand Draft should be drawn in favour of "**Vishwakarma Institute of Technology**" payable at Pune.
13. Confirmation of the allotted seat is subject to the submission of: i) Institute applicable fees, ii) all applicable and required original documents, and iii) the anti-ragging format, to be provided immediately.
14. If a candidate fails to pay requisite Institute's applicable fee or fails to submit applicable original documents or compliance with the anti-ragging policy as per the format during the seat allotment process, such allotment stands cancelled.
15. The student MUST report strictly according to the schedule provided on the institute's website and Notice Board.
16. If a candidate has already taken admission elsewhere, he/she must provide: i) the original fee receipt, ii) the original document retention certificate, and submit a set of photocopies of all documents duly attested by the Principal/Director of the institution where candidate has previously secured admission. Additionally, the candidate must submit an undertaking stating that the original documents will be provided within four working days from the date of admission.
17. Interested candidate must be report in-person for the admission process, however, If the candidate is unable to attend in-person due to unavoidable circumstances, he/she may authorise his/her parent/ guardian to represent him/her for the ACAP round. The

authorized representative (parent/ guardian) must carry i) original & a photocopy of Identity proof of the student as well as himself/herself appointed in capacity as parent / guardian to take decision on behalf of candidate, ii) original authorisation letter duly signed by the Candidate along with i) all applicable documents, ii) demand draft etc. The seat choice made by the authorized representative will be final and binding on the candidate. No claim shall be entertained later in this regard.

18. Any vacancies remaining after this Institute Level Allotment (SPOT - ACAP) round may be posted on the Institute's website. These vacancies may be filled through an additional round, and the detailed schedule for this will be announced on the institute's website at a later date.
19. All Admission are provisional and subject to approval from the Director of Technical Education and Admission Regulating Authority of Maharashtra State.
20. **The decision of the Chairman Admission committee shall be final and binding.**
